Once these ASAP Absolutes are outlined & explained, students give a physical buy-in & sign our HCA posters to make a public commitment to following them.

The foundation of the ASAP program is the Home Court Advantage where we strive to insure that SAFETY, BELONGING, VALUE & COURAGE are part of each & every program day. HCA also is a key component of each of our Recreation Center programs & activities.

#### Safety is our #1 rule!

Physically, we will stay inside the Recreation Center & always within sight of an ASAP teacher. In order to use the bathroom or move throughout the building, we must have permission & update our “X Marks My Spot” sheet or be accompanied by a teacher. We will use safety when playing with each other & supplies such as scissors, hot glue, etc. Also, cell phone usage is limited to the ASAP phone for emergencies only & with staff help.

Emotionally, we also will be safe with each other’s feelings, beliefs & ideas.

*“Courage is what it takes to stand up & speak; courage is also what it takes to sit down & listen.”* Winston Churchill


Physically, we will be courageous in keeping ourselves & others safe. We will stand up for what we believe & for our friends. We will take appropriate risks & try new things.
